Family Service Assists Seniors to Overcome Current Life Challenges

The Older Adults program of Family Service of Napa Valley offers mental health services for seniors throughout Napa County, with sites in Napa and Calistoga.

Seniors are a growing population in Napa Valley who have often been underserved and undertreated for mental health concerns. This population has not traditionally

sought out services for themselves - much of the time their depression and anxiety goes unnoticed for years before healthcare providers or others are made aware of their suffering. This program provides much needed mental health services to the Napa Valley.
